Community Grants Fund Guidance Notes 2025



Eligibility:

The Carlton Rotary Community Grants Fund is open to applications from small community organisations, individuals or groups, for projects based within, and supporting residents of Carlton Rotary's local area, ie Carlton/Netherfield/Gedling/Mapperley.

It is intended to provide funds to support projects or activities which would not be possible without this grant, and which will benefit local people. The maximum sum which can be awarded for a project or activity is £500.

We have a limited budget each year to allocate in grants, so we are not able to fund all requests. Feedback can be requested by unsuccessful applicants.
